This collection contains biographical materials documenting the career and life of Arthur E. Ojeda (1901 - 1985), businessman and stereophotographer.

Biographical Note

Born in 1901, Arthur E. Ojeda lived in southern Arizona as a child and graduated from the University of Arizona. He had a 42 year business career with Standard Oil, during which he traveled widely and lived abroad. He pursued photography as a hobby, with his main interest in stereo slides. Ojeda died in California in 1985 at age 84.
